Staff Report

RE: Constrained Long-Range Multimodal Transportation Plan (CLRMTTP 2040) – Candidate Projects

Candidate projects for the upcoming CLRMTTP 2040 can come from several sources. One source is the Travel Demand Model (TDM) which is being developed by Parson’s Brinkerhoff. Other sources include other regional plans such as the Vision Plans (Pedestrian and Transit), the Congestion Management Plan, the Bicycle Plan etc. Local Comprehensive plans and recent HB2 applications can also be a good source of candidate projects. RVTPO has typically considered regional and local comprehensive planes to be an equally valid source of candidate projects as the TDM. The TDM is a good tool, but not the only tool for the process.

Concerning HB2, one goal of the CLRMTTP 2040 is to produce a financially constrained list of projects and a vision list of projects that can be used to develop and HB2 application strategy for various future HB2 funding scenarios. A good role for the CLRMTTP 2040 would be to help set the big picture for a long-range HB2 strategy for the region.

Staff Report

RE: RSTP Policy Recommendations

The RVTPO discussed the upcoming RSTP Policy Guide update at their January meeting. This will allow them to make decisions at their RVTPO February meeting that will allow staff to develop a draft Policy Guide Update in March. They requested TTC recommendations concerning the following topics:

- **Countercyclical to HB2 Schedule** – Discussion at both the January TTC and the January TPO meetings leaned toward adopting a countercyclical schedule to HB2. This would mean that the next RSTP schedule would open in 2017, 2019, 2021 The RVTPO Board wanted to make sure that the TTC is officially recommending a countercyclical schedule.
- **Re-compete or “Like HB2”** – Our current RSTP Policy Guidelines require projects that have not started receiving funding, or have not gotten a letter to proceed from VDOT or DRPT to re-compete for RSTP funds with new projects when new application/scoring round happens. This has already happened between the first and second RSTP rounds with no negative feedback as far as the staff is aware. The original motivation for “re-competing” was to allow for flexibility in funding new or unknown future opportunities. However, HB2 is based on a completely different philosophy. Once HB2 funds are awarded they are fully funded in the Six Year-Improvement Program. There is no re-competing in the out years of the SYIP. New HB2 projects plug in in the out years when funding starts to become available. The central question to discuss is whether the TTC recommends that RSTP keep the re-compete framework or whether RSTP operate like HB2.
- **Upper Limit on Project Size?** – If we are accepting new RSTP applications on a 2 year schedule, and we choose to recommend that RSTP function like HB2, should there be a limit to RSTP request (i.e. project size). If there is not a limit, a very large project would have the potential to freeze out several years of funding thus negating the purpose of having a 2 year schedule. It may be a difficult to determine an upper limit. Here are some ideas for discussion:

Upper Limit	Approximate Impact
1 – year worth of RSTP funding	Allows at least 2 applications to be funded each two years cycle starting in the earliest available out years of the six-year RSTP financial plan.
2 – years’ worth of RSTP funding	Allows at least 1 application to be funded each two year cycle starting in the earliest available out years of the six-year RSTP financial plan.
3 –years’ worth of RSTP funding	Allows one project to take up to 50% of RSTP funding in a six-year RSTP financial plan. However this would potentially impact the purpose of a two year application cycle.
Other	Ideas from the TTC?
No limit	If a large project “wins” we may have to suspend subsequent application rounds until funds become available. A large project could crowd out other projects for many years.

RE: Narrative for discretionary UPWP projects

This staff report contains draft narrative for discretionary UPWP candidate projects. You and the TPO Policy Board have discussed project ideas in past meetings. The following narrative attempts to incorporate the various ideas, tradeoffs and desired outcomes that were previously discussed. The nomenclature of 2.AA, 2.AB etc. is just a stand-in because we don't know the section numbers of the entire draft work program yet.

2.AA RVTPO Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning

Objective and Description: A continued effort to implement recommendations from the Regional Bikeway Plan, the Regional Pedestrian Vision Plan and the Regional Transit Vision plan is the organizing framework underlying Item 2.AA. In addition to this general effort the following specific plans, studies and tasks will be accomplished in the FY17 UPWP.

- **Regional Bicycle and Workforce Commuting Study** – Multimodal access to employment opportunities is a key component of improved transportation options, workforce development, community/economic development and an overall Livable Roanoke Valley. Previous efforts had focused on public transit's role in connecting people with employment opportunities. This study would take an in depth look at the bicycle modes potential in connecting people with employment opportunities in the RVTPO. Specifically this study will identify target populations who use or would potentially use the bicycle mode to primarily access employment opportunities. In addition the study will identify employers who would be willing and interested in increasing the size of their workforce through accessing bicycle commuters. Finally the study will analyze and recommend specific bicycle accommodations, programs, policies and approaches that are designed to facilitate access to employment and workforce development through the bicycle mode of transportation.
- **Engaging New and/or Traditionally Underserved Communities in Bicycle Planning and Outreach – Strategic Plan** – Public involvement in the planning process is often successful in engaging those citizens who have the time, means, interest and opportunity to attend public meetings and otherwise participate in the process. This strategic plan would focus on removing barriers to participation and/or facilitation participation for communities whose members may not have the means or opportunity to attend public meetings or participate through other well established channels. These communities are often identified in other planning efforts as Environmental Justice (EJ) Communities and/or Title VI Communities. This strategic plan would start with EJ and Title VI communities as a launching point and investigate where there are also other new of traditionally underserved communities as well. Finally, a strategic plan will be produced for better engaging these communities specifically with regards to bicycle planning.
- **Pedestrian Performance Measures Data Collection - Continuing** - Update shapefiles and related databases of pedestrian infrastructure and where necessary, in the field, gather pedestrian infrastructure data along public streets and bus routes to include sidewalks, crosswalks,

pedestrian signals, and ADA curb ramps. Special effort and attention will be made for mapping the above amenities that lie within ¼ mile of a fixed route bus stop.

- **Regional Pedestrian/Bicycle Advisory Board** - RVTPO staff will continue to staff the Regional Pedestrian/Bicycle Advisory Committee. In addition, staff will attend meetings and/or serve on the following committees: City of Roanoke BAC, Regional Greenway Commission, Regional Greenway Commission Standards and Design Subcommittee, Joint Greenway Commission-Pathfinders Marketing, PR and Education Subcommittee and other committees as appointed.
- **General, Mapping and Website Assistance to Local Governments and Greenway Commission** – MPO Staff assistance, public information materials design, and assistance in other areas as necessary.
- **Continued Greenway Monitoring and User Counts** – continue to expand the greenway usage monitoring/estimation system for using during all seasons. Monitoring system will include deployment of additional trail counters and other monitors as available.
- **National Bicycle and Pedestrian Documentation Project Counts - Continuing** – RVTPO will partner with local governments to continue bicycle and pedestrian snapshot counts as part of the National Bicycle and Pedestrian Documentation Project.
- **Grant Assistance for Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure Development** – Assist local stakeholders in identifying and pursuing state, local, federal and private grants for new bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure.
- **Tinker Creek Greenway Connectivity Study Assistance Phase II**- The Tinker Creek Greenway Connectivity Study is a multijurisdictional effort to connect the established greenway segments in Roanoke City and in Roanoke County/Botetourt County and to expand the scope of the greenway to the northeast into Botetourt County. Planning analysis with stakeholder and community input is needed to determine the best location for the greenway between the current construction terminus at Orange Avenue in Roanoke City, the existing Hollins University Trailhead north of Interstate 81 in Roanoke County, and the proposed Daleville Greenway in Botetourt County. The proposed schedule will extend over several fiscal years and UPWPs as follows:
 - Phase I - July 2015-June 2016: City of Roanoke (FY 2016)
 - Phase II - July 2016-June 2017: Roanoke County (FY 2017)
 - Phase III - July 2017-June 2018: Botetourt County (FY 2018)

2.AB Regional Greenway Plan Update

Objective and Description: The last Regional Greenway Plan was approved in FY07. A lot has changed in the subsequent 10 years necessitating a fresh update of the Regional Greenway Plan. New funding sources, prioritization and programming methods including HB2 and Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funding have been established. The core concept and vision of the regional greenway system is now established, the Bike Plan was updated in 2012 and implementation has been growing, and a Pedestrian Plan has been completed. In addition Botetourt County is looking to join the Greenway Commission. This regional greenway plan update will focus on developing the greenway system into a true multimodal network, identifying connections with the regional pedestrian, bicycle, and transit

networks, enabling connectivity with activity generators in regional multimodal centers and districts, and reviewing implementation strategies. This update will utilize recent work in the Regional Pedestrian Vision Plan, the Bike Plan, and the Transit Plan as a basic framework from which to proceed.

2.AC Regional Land Use and Transportation

Objective and Description: The A project that would coordinate local government efforts around transportation and land-use by: utilizing the existing Multimodal Centers and Districts Framework; analyzing local zoning and land use compatibility with regional multimodal transportation; conducting visual preference surveys to solicit preferences of the existing built environment; instilling and fostering principles of Smart Growth (e.g. compact building design, mixed-use and transit oriented development); and utilizing the VDOT Transportation Efficient Land Use and Design guide. Products of this effort may include model comprehensive plan/zoning ordinance language, overlay districts, urban design guidelines, area specific pattern books, and other products that could be used by localities in their own planning efforts.

2.AD Corridor Studies, Area Studies and Safety Planning

Objective and Description: Corridor and area studies can uncover projected ideas that feed the CLRMTP. Likewise, the CLRMTP can suggest corridors that warrant pre-NEPA corridor studies to help move the project to next stage. The following corridors and areas were suggested by local governments and other stakeholders in the FY2017 work program development process. Analysis of each corridor or area may include but is not limited to: access management, operations evaluation, transit/bicycle/pedestrian connections, parking availability/accessibility/issues, current and future land use, existing activity density, and adjacent land zoning.

- **Route 419 Phase II**– The purpose is to continue the study initiated in FY16 on Route 419 from Route 220 to Route 221.
- **Brambleton Avenue Corridor Study Phase II** – The purpose is to continue the study initiated in FY16 on Brambleton Avenue.
- **Botetourt County Transportation Section of Comprehensive Plan Phase III** – Assistance to Botetourt County staff in the preparation of a transportation section of their comprehensive plan update. This UPWP portion will focus on the portion of the county that is within the RVTPO Study Area. A companion element for the rural portion of Botetourt County is in the FY2017 RVARC Rural Transportation Program Scope of Work. Work tasks are anticipated to include but not be limited to:
- **Exit 150 Small Area Study - Phase II** – The purpose is to prepare a comprehensive plan amendment that ties transportation, land-use and economic development together in the area around Exit 150 and the Southern Portion (i.e. RVTPO Study Area) of the County.
- **Regional Multimodal Corridors Identification** – This is a continuation of work started in the FY15 Work Program that defined multimodal districts and centers. The idea is to define to the regional multimodal corridors where infrastructure supporting public transportation, walking,

and biking exists or is desired. This will allow us to suggest the multimodal corridors for inclusion in VTRANS updates and help us identify potential HB2 projects.

- ***Intersection or corridor analysis as requested.***
- ***General HB2 or UDA assistance as requested by local governments.***

Particular attention to safety planning will be present in the corridor planning process. This may include but is not limited to: accident analysis, pedestrian safety, bicycle safety, driver behavior analysis and education.

Staff Report

Re: Federal Certification Review of the RVTPO Planning Process

Attached please find a copy of the Federal Certification Review letter that was sent to RVTPO Policy Board Chair Jane Johnson for your reference.

The Federal Certification Review is required of all Transportation Management Area (TMA) Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) every 4 years. This is our first Federal Certification Review. The review will take place March 2 and 3, 2016 in our office. There will also be a Public Meeting from 4:30 to 7:30 pm on March 2nd. This public meeting will be run by the Federal Team reviewing us, not RVTPO staff. The venue for the Public Meeting is being decided.

It is important to note that the Federal Certification Review will likely uncover items that need to be improved over the next 4 years. This has been the experience of other TMA MPOs in Virginia during their reviews. Compared to other TMA MPOs we have a relatively small staff size. Out of the myriad federal rules and regulations concerning MPO planning there are bound to be areas that we haven't had ability to fully address. Staff will diligently implement feedback from this process over the next 4 years.

We don't expect any major findings or deficiencies; we just wanted to let you know that this is not a "pat on the back" type of review. Its purpose is to improve the process. Since no MPO is perfect, there will always be areas of improvement identified after a two day review.

Staff has already provided the "Desk Review" items that were requested in the letter.

Dear Ms. Johnson:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) will be conducting a site visit for the Federal Certification Review of the Roanoke Valley TPO Planning Process. As agreed upon through prior discussions with the MPO staff, this site visit has been scheduled for March 2-3, 2016. The Federal Certification Review is intended to determine if the region's transportation planning process is addressing the major issues facing the area in accordance with the applicable Federal regulations, and will look at the cooperative planning process as conducted by the State, transit operator, and local governments in the area. Consequently, we will not be conducting a pass/fail review, but rather we intend to highlight good practices, exchange information, and identify opportunities for improvements.

The Federal Certification Review is required every four years for all Transportation Management Areas (TMAs). Urbanized areas with 200,000 or more population are referred to in Federal legislation as TMAs. The Federal Certification of TMAs was first required by the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA), which established a requirement in 23 U.S.C. 134 and 49 U.S.C. 1607 for the FHWA and the FTA to jointly certify the metropolitan transportation planning process in MPOs that are designated TMAs at least once every three years. As revised by the enactment of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) (P.L. 109-59), and the enactment of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) (P.L. 112-141), 23 U.S.C. 134 and 49 U.S.C. 5303 continue to require that the FHWA/FTA jointly certify the metropolitan transportation planning processes in TMAs at least once every four years. Federal Certification Reviews must also "provide for public involvement appropriate to the metropolitan area under review."

The formal review is tentatively scheduled to begin at 9:00 AM and end at 4:00 PM on March 2nd. The location of the Federal Certification Review will be provided in advance of the site visit. The discussion will continue from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM on March 3rd. Since policy and technical

issues are likely to be discussed, please ensure that appropriate representatives are present during the site visit to address questions that may arise. An agenda and a list of questions that are planned to be discussed will be provided to the MPO staff prior to the site visit.

In addition, there will be an opportunity for the public, including key MPO committee members and special interest groups, to express their views on the transportation planning process being conducted in the metropolitan area. This public meeting is scheduled for the evening of March 2nd, from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM. Please ensure that this opportunity for public participation is advertised in accordance with the MPO's adopted Public Involvement Plan. In general, the public meeting will further focus on the MPO's various approaches, activities, and issues associated with conducting the "3-C" (Coordinated, Continuing, and Comprehensive) metropolitan transportation planning process.

The FHWA and FTA Team wish to accomplish the Federal Certification Review through the following phases: 1) desk review of planning products and processes; 2) a site visit including public meeting; and 3) a certification report. Over the next several weeks, our office will be coordinating with your staff to finalize the site visit agenda. To aid the Federal agencies in conducting the desk review, the FHWA and FTA ask that you provide two copies (paper or electronic) of the following documents to the FHWA Division and one copy (paper or electronic) to the FTA Region III office, by **January 29, 2016**:

- MPO Agreements and MOUs identifying planning responsibilities,
- Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP),
- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP),
- LRTP and TIP Financial Plans,
- Brief Narrative of LRTP and TIP Development Processes,
- Public Participation Plan (PPP),
- Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP),
- Congestion Management Process (CMP), and
- Civil Rights program documents.

Upon completion of the desk review, a list of items and issues identified for further review and discussion during the on-site review will be provided to you.

As part of the site visit, an informal closeout session will be held with the MPO to discuss preliminary review findings (i.e., corrective actions, recommendations and/or commendations). After the site visit, the Federal Review Team will prepare a MPO Certification Review report that summarizes the site visit and provides the Federal Review Team's preliminary review findings. In addition to assessing the MPO's current level of effort in addressing statutory and regulatory requirements, the Federal Certification Review is intended to offer input and examples from other States and MPOs in improving the overall quality of the area's metropolitan transportation planning process. The MPO Federal Certification Review report will be finalized within 90 days of the conclusion of the site visit. Within this timeframe, the respective MPO planning staffs will be provided fourteen calendar days to provide factual verification on the content of the draft report when received.
