WHEREAS, the RVTPO Transportation Technical Committee, the Virginia Department of Transportation, and relevant project sponsor(s) have concurred with adjustments to the future timing of allocations as shown in the financial plan for the following projects:

- Walnut Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Accommodations (5th Street to City/Town limit)
- Route 419/U.S. 220 Diverging Diamond Interchange
- Roanoke River Greenway through Explore Park
- Walnut Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Accommodations (W. Lee Avenue to 1st Street)
- Starkey Road/Buck Mountain Road Intersection Improvements
