#### RESOLUTION

#### **Endorsing the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) PriorIties**

**WHEREAS**, the Roanoke Valley Area Metropolitan Planning Organization is now classified as a Transportation Management Area (TMA) MPO as a result of Census 2010 population; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Policy Board has a new opportunity and responsibility to prioritize Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds within the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Study Area Boundary; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Policy Board approves the (attached) RSTP Project Ranking and the RSTP Six-Year Financial Plan Recommendations to the Virginia Commonwealth Transportation Board; and,

**WHEREAS**, the RSTP Six-Year Financial Plan Recommendations are to be interpreted in a manner similar to a local government's Capital Improvement Program or the Virginia Department of Transportation's Six-Year Improvement Program, in which the first year (FY'14) represents committed funds (obligations) and years two through six (FY'15 – FY'19) represent a financial plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Policy Board will review RSTP funding and progress on a yearly basis as described in the Roanoke Valley Area MPO RSTP Project Development and Selection Procedures (Approved 03-28-2013), and decide whether or not to request new applications in any given year; and,

**WHEREAS**, in any year in which the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Policy Board does not accept new applications, the yearly review of the RSTP Six-Year Financial Plan will be updated to reflect current costs and a new sixth year of funding; and,

**WHEREAS**, in any year in which the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Policy Board decides to accept new applications, a new RSTP Project Ranking and a new RSTP Six-Year Financial Plan Recommendations document will be developed and become applicable at the time of approval, superseding any previously approved documents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Roanoke Valley Area MPO Policy Board endorses the project priorities described in the (attached) RSTP Project Ranking and the RSTP Six-Year Financial Plan and forwards this supporting resolution/endorsement to the Virginia Commonwealth Transportation Board.
